RECENT SENIOR THESIS PROJECTS:

Evaluation of Sarasota Bay as a Potential Shark Nursery Habitat

This study was the first to quantitatively survey Sarasota Bay as a potential shark Essential Fish Habitat, as mandated by the Magnuson-Stevens Act of 1996. Gill nets were used to catch and analyze 178 sharks representing five species. This abundance of shark species provided preliminary evidence for support of Sarasota Bay as a nursery habitat.

The Power of Public Opinion: Hunger Strike and the Irish Women's Suffrage Movement (1912-1914) This project explored how public opinion in early 20th century Ireland turned in favor of granting women the right to vote following revelations of police force-feeding jailed suffragettes who were participating in hunger strikes as a means of political protest.

Crash Land Falling Through Immersive Theatre: An Examination of and Experimentation in Audience Engagement in Live Performance This thesis explored immersive theatre as a relatively new movement that breaks the conventions of traditional theatre. The project featured a production of "Iphigenia Crash Land Falls on the Neon Shell that Once was Her Heart: a Rave Fable" by Caridad Svich, a piece of traditional theatre adapted into the immersive theatre style.
