Does this 30-page limit include cover and tab/divider pages or does it only count content pages?</p>	<p>8/24/20 - The 30-page limit does NOT include the cover and tab/divider pages - only the content pages.</p>
3	<p>8/18/20 - I would like to request, if possible, information pertaining to our submittal to RFQ 62918CM back in August of 2018. As I was not with the firm at the time, I do not believe that anyone requested a debrief or followed up for score sheets. If this information is available, I would like to request it at this time.</p> <p>Additionally, I would like to know who currently holds a Continuing Contract for Construction Management Services – RFQ # 8112003? As it states in the current solicitation that Construction Managers currently working a NCF are subject to discretionary renewal and need not apply again.</p>	<p>8/25/20 - Regarding your first question, that information is not available at this time. In regard to your second question, all Construction Managers, current or potential, must submit for the current solicitation.</p>

4	8/19/20 - Can this RFQ be double-sided, print on front and back? Where the 30 pages are be printed on front and back.	8/20/20 - You may submit your RFQ in double-sided print format, but since there would be information printed on each side of the page, each double-sided page would count as 2 pages instead of 1.
