WHO MUST TAKE THE PLACEMENT EXAM?

If you want to enroll in Spanish this year FOR THE FIRST TIME AT NEW COLLEGE AND if you HAVE STUDIED THE LANGUAGE BEFORE you attended New College, *OR* if you have taken Spanish classes at New College but DISCONTINUED YOUR WOK IN THE LANGUAGE, please take the ON-LINE PLACEMENT EXAM.

This on-line placement exam takes from five to twenty minutes depending on your performance, and new questions will be generated based on responses. Please set aside 30 minutes to make sure you have enough time. To access the placement exam, please follow the instructions below. We will receive your scores electronically; you do not need to send them to us.

In addition to taking this exam, we advise you to ATTEND THE APPROPRIATE MINI-CLASS on Thursday, January 27, AND YOU MUST COMPLETE A 'PLACEMENT FORM'.
