**1:30 pm - End of Day - *Various Locations***

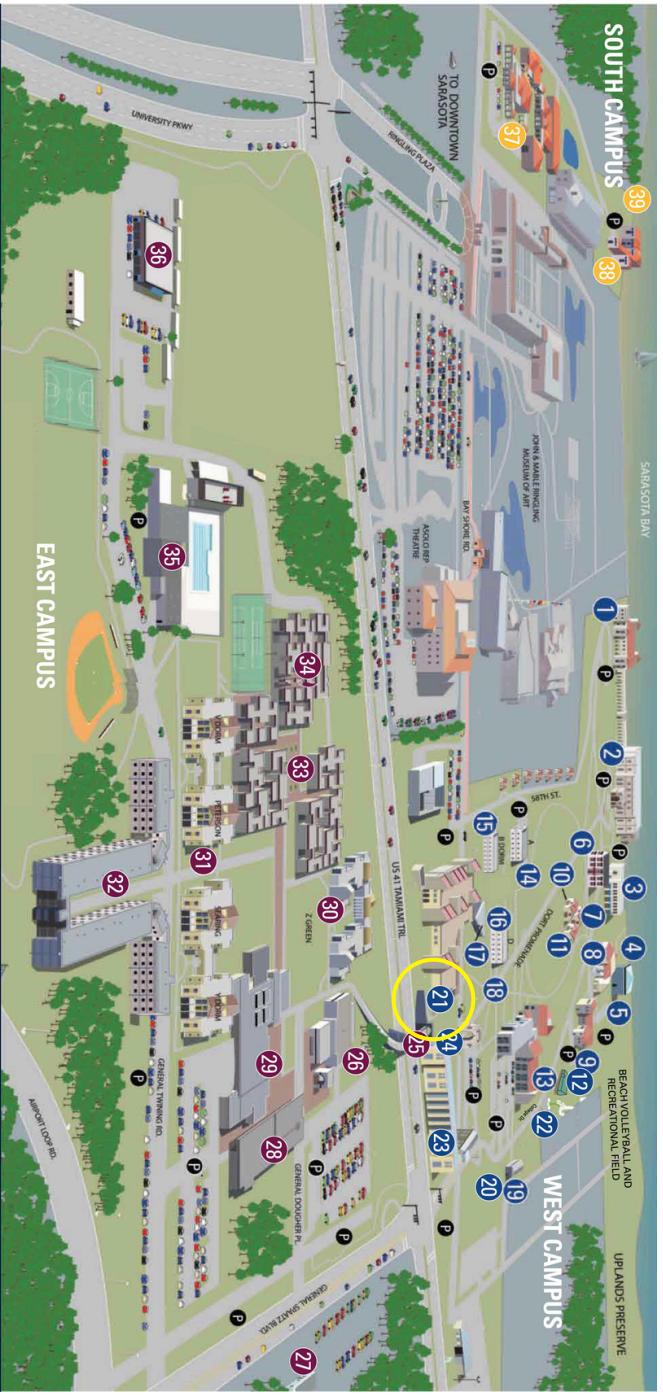
